Vishnu, in mercy and compassion, came to earth as Narasimha, a man-lion being. Narasimha sought out the evil tyrant's dwelling place and waited.

At twilight, he entered, dragged him on to the threshold, and holding him firmly Narasimha spoke, "It is neither day nor night. It is on the threshold of your building, neither inside nor outside. I am neither beast nor Man, but a combination of both. Therefore I now destroy you".
